This Memorandum of Clarification is entered into between Seattle Public Schools ("SPS"), the employer, and Seattle Education Association ("SEA") and will apply to all three bargaining units represented under the SEA.

For the 2025- 2026 school year only, the principal will review the building and District discipline standards and the enforcement of those standards during the first District-directed staff meeting or by September 30, 2025.

For the 2025-2026 school year only, the principal and/or the District will provide each regularly assigned staff member with either electronic or paper copies of the Basic Rules of Seattle Public Schools and WAC 392-400, and a copy of the building staff handbook which is to contain a specific section focused on building discipline standards, protocols, and expectations upon board approval or no later than September 30, 2025.
